WHY "MY DAILY DOSE"?

Just as many people take a daily dose of vitamins, medicine, or dietary supplements in order to be healthy, the concept behind "My Daily Dose" is the same. Even a small daily dose of God's Word can help us grow and become spiritually healthy and strong.
